A GUIDE TO SOME OF THE BEST AFTERMARKET HANDGUN SIGHTS

ou like the pistol you've chosen for concealed carry, but somehow it could be just a little bit better. In the days when revolvers were king, the first thing, if anything, that you changed was the grips. In this age of polymer-frame semi-auto pistols that's a bit harder to do, although many come with interchangeable backstraps or palm swells.

Today, you're more apt to swap out the sights. Maybe you're having trouble seeing the sights and you want a bright fiber optic set. Or maybe you want night sights for low-light defensive use. Maybe you need higher sights to peek above the suppressor you've thinking of adding. The good news is that there's a great selection of aftermarket sights from companies that specialize in sights or gun optics. Here we're highlighting some of the best that you can buy to get your gun on target quickly and accurately.

Gun Pro Delta 1 Sights With many sights, you have to choose between fast acquisition and precision. But Delta 1 Sights from Gun Pro aren't your ordinary aftermarket sights. They feature a wide, orange front sight with an inverted triangle notch on top. The rear is an acrylic, high-visibility, lime green triangle. For quick acquisition, that large front sight jumps right up in front of you when you present your handgun on target, and the wide notch provides an excellent, open view. But place the top of the triangle rear sight at the bottom of the front notch and that single-point alignment provides a high degree of precision for accurate shot placement. After a few rounds to adjust to the new sight picture, these sights are very fast and accurate. They are highly visible in daylight and they're also photo-luminescent—once they're exposed to some light, they glow in the dark. The sights are available for Glock, Smith & Wesson, Sig Sauer, Springfield Armory and 1911 (Novak cut) pistols.

Night Fision Perfect Dot

Night Fision Perfect Dot night sights are made in the U.S. of machined 4140 steel coated with black nitride for corrosion and wear resistance. They make use of a patent-pending injection-molded aluminum sleeves that hold the tritium vials in place—a more durable design that also provides for a brighter sight. The front sight features a choice of a white, orange or yellow florescent ring around the tritium, so the sights are easy to acquire day or night. The rear sights are available with either a U-notch or a square notch, outlined, black or blank. The sights are available for Glock, Canik, Smith & Wesson, Sig Sauer and Springfield Armory handguns.
